



Brighton Preschool Admission Agreement

1. You agree to and accept the policies and procedures of the school as set forth in the contract and in the Parent Handbook, any additional policies or procedures implemented after this date of which you are notified, and any specific requirements imposed by applicable governmental agencies.
2. There is no discrimination made between applicants for enrollment on the basis of race, age, sex, color, political affiliation, marital status, creed, national origin, religion, or disabilities. There is no sibling priority placement. Placement is based on application date. We also take into consideration the balance between genders.
3. All children are accepted on condition that they are able to meet minimum learning and sociability requirements. I may ask you to withdraw your child from the school if we reasonably determine that the child either cannot or will not meet those requirements. When a child is asked to leave the school the remainder of the tuition will be refunded.
4. You need to give notice two month in advance. We ONLY enroll students who will be with us for a full year.
5. The tuition and all extra expenses are billed on the 15th of each month. Tuition is due 5 days before the first day of the month.
6. Again, tuition is payable over a 12-month school year (September – August), with each due before the 1st.
7. There are NO MAKE-UPS and tuition is not subject to adjustment because of illness, vacation, holidays, other absence or voluntary withdrawal from school prior to the completion of the school year.
8. It is required that each family:
 - Volunteer by making a presentation of “Your Culture” in December, or “What I do at Work” in May.
 - Participate in our fundraisers: escrip, Box Tops, and Oceana Market card.
 - Bring in your Red Book Bag at the beginning of every week, with 10 books in it.
 - Bring an object and clues for the Guessing Game each Friday. (The object’s name starts with the letter that we are studying that week.
 - Donate seeds or seedlings for the Vegetable Garden, which the students start planting in March.
 - Provide an Earthquake Backpack for their child.
9. Front gate MUST be locked at all times. Do not climb over gate. Do not let children unlock gate.
10. Parents must replace any toy broken by their child.
